

YARN USED: **B, D & C**

B: 136 Mustard



D: 18 Poppy



C: 40 White



CANDLESTICK

WHAT YOU NEED

2 - 3¼mm (UK9 - US5) knitting needles. 3.25mm (UK 10 - US D/3) crochet hook.

CANDLESTICK (make 3)

Using **B** cast on 9 sts and P one row.

Shape Base

1st row - [Inc into every st] to end. 18 sts.

2nd row - Purl.

3rd row - K1, [inc 1, K1] 8 times, K1. 26 sts.

P2 rows for fold line.

6th row - P2, [P2tog, P1] 8 times. 18 sts.

7th row - Knit.

8th row - P1, [P2tog] 8 times, P1. 10 sts. Knit 1 row.

Break off **B**.

Using **C** work 9 rows in st st commencing with a P row.

Next row - K1, [K2tog, K1] 3 times. 7 sts.

Next row - [P2tog] 3 times, P1, 4 sts. Break off **C**.

Using **B** Knit 1 row.

Next row - P1, [inc in next st purlwise] twice, P1. 6 sts.

Next row - K1, sl 1, K1, pss0, K2tog, K1. 4 sts.

Next row - [P2tog] twice.

Next row - Sl, K1, pss0, fasten off.

Handle

Using **B** cast on 10 sts then cast off. Fasten off and attach to base forming a loop.

MAKING UP

Using **D** embroider centre of flame. Join back seam. Using **B** work a gathering thread through every stitch along base edge, draw up tightly and fasten off, then join seam from this point up. Fasten base to candle and secure tightly.

Using **C** work chain stitch embroidery to resemble dripping candle wax. Using **C** and a 3.25mm crochet hook work a 10 chain hanging loop and attach to back of candle.

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
