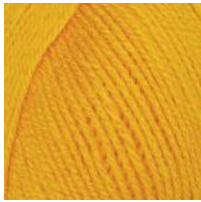


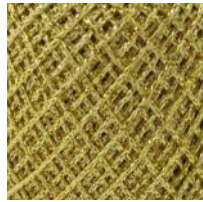

WHAT YOU NEED

3.00mm crochet hook.
Optional Fairy Lights.
Jewellery Wire.
Polyester craft filling.

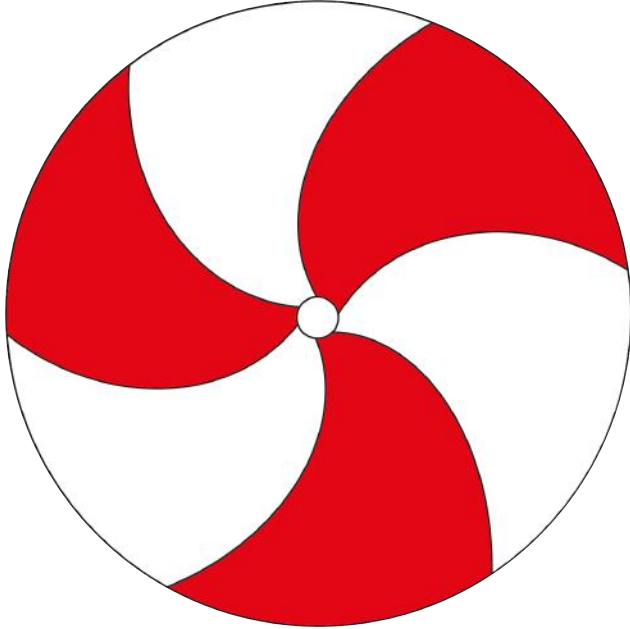

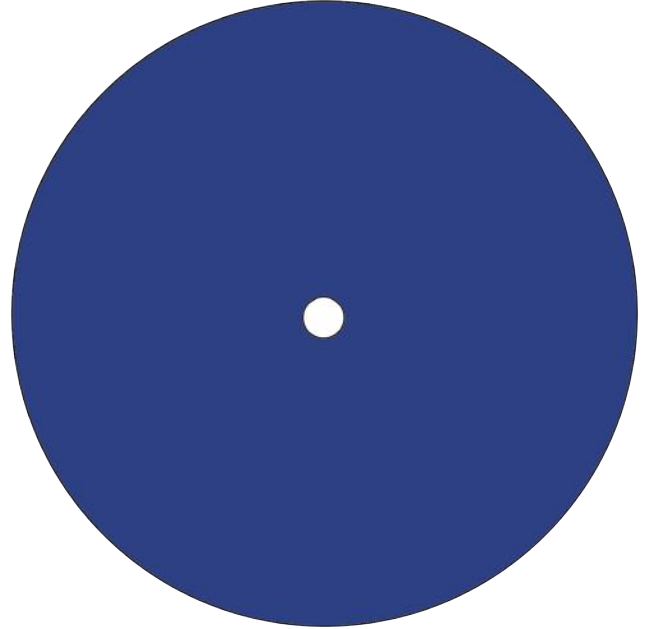


Crochet components for Carousel Canopy

One Foam Board Circle.



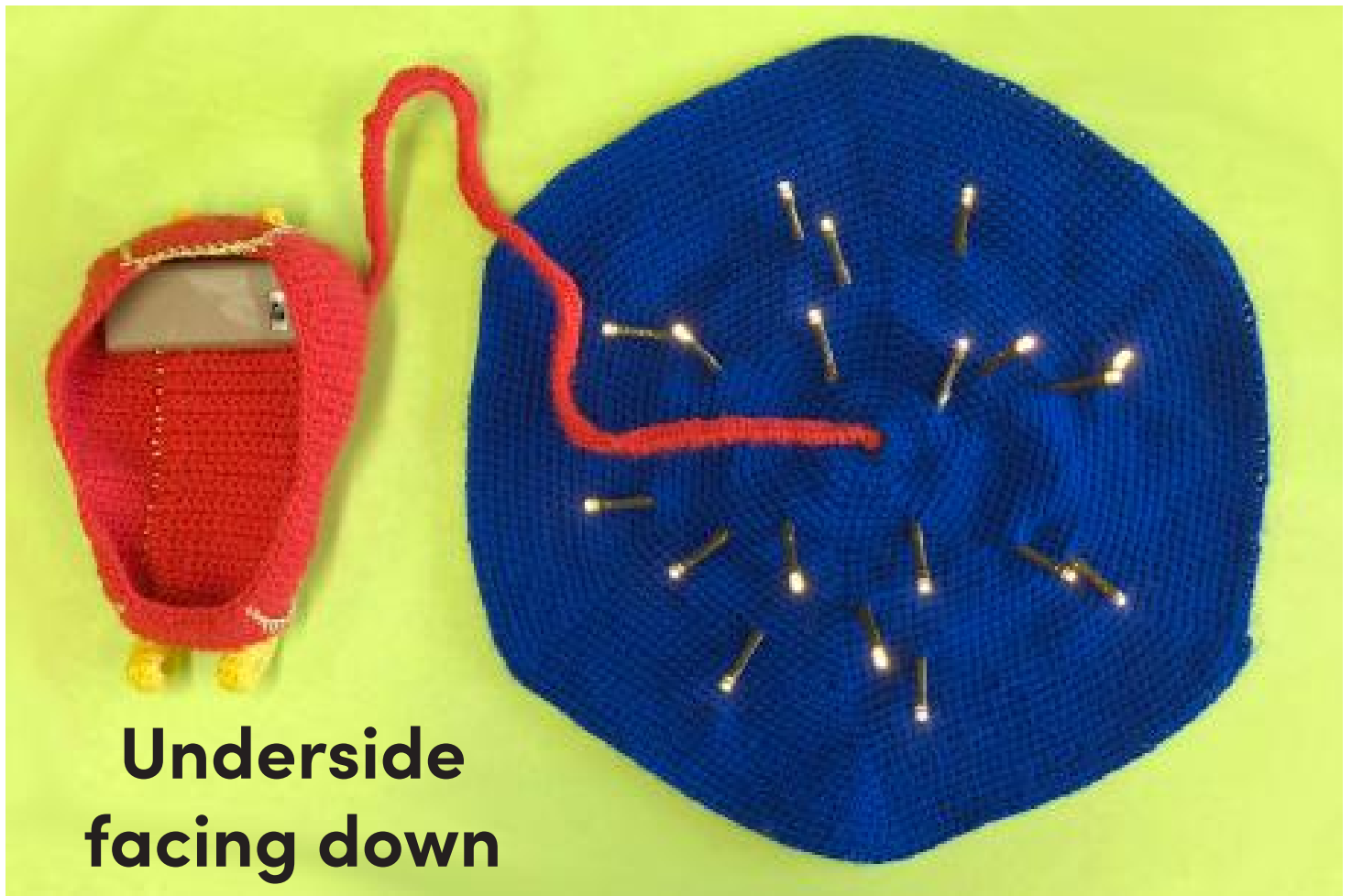

Optional Fairy Lights

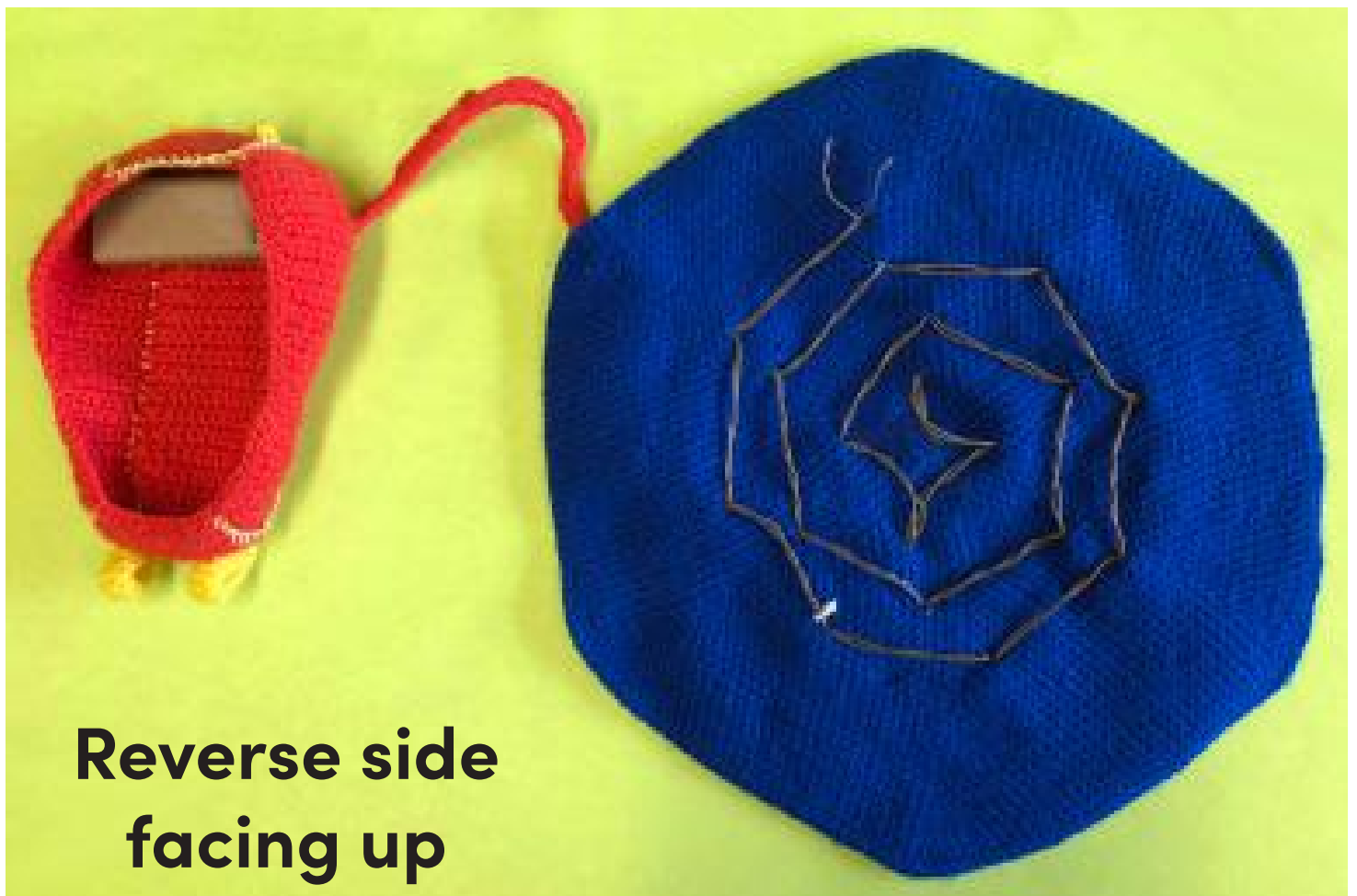
Using 3.00mm hook and Red, work sc's around the wire of the fairy lights until it is completely covered.

Place the battery pack in the back of Santas Sleigh and thread the wire through the side panel. Wind the wire around the centre dowl in a spiral and thread the lights through the centre hole of **C2**. On the reverse of **C2** push the individual lights through the fabric so they are evenly spaced. Continue with Canopy construction.

Canopy Construction

Lay **C1** on top of **C2**, lining up the holes and making sure if using fairy lights they are pointing downwards rather than upwards. Using 3.00mm hook and mustard work 1 sc through both pieces in each st approx half way around. Insert **FB2** and continue to work 1 sc in each st until the gap is closed between all pieces. Do not break yarn.



Crochet half way around



Insert foam board inbetween two crochet pieces and continue to crochet together.

Canopy Edging

Continuing to use a 3.00mm hook and Mustard work 1 sc in each st around for 6 rounds.

7th round - [ss, sc, hdc, dc, tr, tr, tr, tr, dc, hdc, sc, ss] over next 12 sts.

Rept around.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Using 3.00mm hook and Goldfingering make a chain long enough to go around the edge of the carousel. Sew in place.

Sew Canopy decorations evenly around edge.



Work 6 rounds of sc in each st.



**[ss, sc, hdc, dc, tr, tr, tr, tr, dc, hdc, sc, ss] over next 12 sts.
Rept around.**



Make a gold chain and stitch in place



Sew canopy decorations evenly around the edge.

Position the Canopy
approx 25cm, 10ins
above the base.

Insert dowel
through top
of canopy
and down
into the
base.

MAKING UP

Insert dowel through top of Canopy and down through into the base. Secure the base by stitching through the base into the dowel cover. If using lights, wrap the light cord around the dowel. Position the Canopy approx 25cm, 10ins above base. Secure the top of the Canopy to the dowel.

Sew the trees to the base using photograph as a guide. Position the Sleigh on base and sew in place. Sew two Reindeers to base in front of Sleigh. Using Jewellery wire cut 4 pieces. Hang the wires from the underneath by hooking through fabric. Use photograph as a guide for position. Create a hook at the end of each wire and attach to a Reindeer by hooking wire through top of Body. You can position Reindeer as high or low as you like by altering the length of wire. Place Santa, Sack and Present in Sleigh. Using goldfingering make two chains the same length so they are long enough to reach from Santa's hands to the muzzle of the two Reindeer in front. Using a crochet hook pull the two ends through Santa's hands and attach one end of the other to the muzzle of one Reindeer and then the other chain end to the other Reindeer.



Sew trees to base



Thread reins through Santa's hands.
