YARN USED: C & B

Robin DK



C: 40 White



B: 136 Mustard

FAIRY and SNOWFLAKE

WHAT YOU NEED

2 - 3¾mm (UK9 - US5)
knitting needles, 3.25mm (UK
10 - US D/3) crochet hook.
Polyester craft filling. Pink
Embroidery thread for hands.

FAIRY (make 1)

HALO

Using C, cast on 23 sts.

Purl one row.

Now work picot cast off as
follows:-

Cast off 2 sts, *sl rem st on right
needle onto left needle, cast on
2 sts, cast off 4 sts, rept from *
to end and fasten off.

BODY

Using C cast on 36 sts using the
two needle method.

1st row - Knit.

2nd row - Purl.

3rd row - [K1, K2tog] to end. 24
sts.

4th row - Purl.

5th row - [K2tog] to end. 12 sts.
Commencing with a P row, work
12 rows in st st.

Next row - Inc in first st, P to last
st, inc in this st. 14 sts.

Commencing with a K row, work
8 rows in st st.

Next row - [K2tog] to end. 7 sts.
Draw yarn through rem 7 sts,
gather and fasten off.



WINGS (make 4)

Using **B**, cast on 3 sts.

1st row - K1, P1, K1.

2nd row - P1, K into front, then back, then front of next st, P1. 5 sts.

3rd row - K1, P3, K1.

4th row - P1, [K1, yon] twice, K1, P1. 7 sts.

5th row - K1, P5, K1.

6th row - P1, K2, yon, K1, yon, K2, P1. 9 sts.

7th row - K1, P7, K1.

Cast off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Using **C** cast on 13 sts.

Work in st st dec 1 st at each end of every alt row to 3 sts.

K3tog and fasten off. Join sleeve seams.

MAKING UP

Join back seam of Body, lightly stuffing head and working a drawstring round neck. Attach sleeves to body. Secure sleeve at centre front with embroidery thread to form hands. For hair attach lengths of **B** to head around hair line. For Halo, join row end edges and attach to top of head. Attach wings to back as in photograph.

Embroider, eyes and mouth as in photograph. Sew Fairy securely to top of Tree.

SNOWFLAKE (make 3)

Using **C** cast on 10 sts.

Next row – Inc in every st to end. 20

sts.

Purl one row.

Work first point by * K4, turn, P4 turn, K1, sl, K1, pssso, K1, turn, P3tog, * fasten off. Break yarn leaving enough to work 4 more points. Sew yarn down left side of point to meet sts on needle. Leave needle threaded. Work 2nd point with the same length of yarn and work from * to *. Work 3rd, 4th and 5th points in the same way. Join yarn at centre. Sew a running thread around centre on wrong side and pull tightly, secure ends. Make a 10 chain hanging loop using a 3.25mm hook and attach to back.
